Scope:		
This policy applies to all students of Southwest Fire Academy		
Purpose: To establish a policy in accordance with the Ontario Career Colleges Act, 2005 governing the use of students' private information		
Procedure:		
Southwest Fire Academy will only use students' private information for the following reasons: 1. To advise students of their rights under the <i>Ontario Career Colleges Act, 2005</i> including rights to a refund of fees, access to transcripts and a formal student complaint procedure;		
 To collect information on the performance of students for example, the percentage of students who graduate from programs and the percentage of graduates who find employment; and 		
 To determine whether Southwest Fire Academy has met the performance objectives required by the Superintendent for its vocational programs. 		
Students will receive and fill out SFA Form 400-002 Use of Personal Information as part of the enrolment procedure.
